As the summer holidays start, we urge you to enjoy the many camping, fishing and hiking accesses of TFL 44 safely and wisely.

Sadly, people are fatally injured every year while operating ATVs on logging roads. Please note that the same common sense and rules of the road you follow when driving on paved public roads apply equally to industrial roads, however, these roads and trails have additional hazards to be aware of:



Loose gravel makes quick stopping very difficult and can cause any vehicle— including ATVs— to slide at high speeds. Stop in single file off of traveled roadways in wide areas (do NOT stop on bridges, narrow sections of road, etc).



Blind corners, overhanging brush and dust make it very hard to see what is just ahead (heavy equipment and other vehicles may be coming from the opposite direction at any time— including weekends). Drive with your lights on at all times and always make eye contact with Equipment Operators before passing heavy equipment. When approaching main roads, stop and check in all directions before proceeding.
