DEVELOPMENT OF A PEST MANAGEMENT PLAN

Notice is given that a draft Pest Management Plan has been prepared by the applicant for the purpose of vegetation management, using the principles of integrated pest management.

The use of pesticides is intended within the area to which the Pest Management Plan applies. Non-chemical methods include manual girdling and cutting, using hand tools and/or powered brushing saws.

Pesticides: The active ingredients and trade names for the pesticides proposed for use under this plan include: Glyphosate (trade names: Vision, VisionMax and Vantage) and Triclopyr (trade name: Release).

Application Method: Glyphosate and Triclopyr will be applied by ground foliar spray and stem injection.

The PMP is for forest lands managed by Western Forest Product's North Island Forest Operation, which encompasses three operating zones, Holberg, Port McNeill and Jeune Landing. The pest management activities are to be carried out on Tree Farm License 6, Forest License A94737, Managed Forests (MF) 29, 31 & 61 and Timber License (T0860). There are silviculture obligations within BC Timber Sales take back area that will also be covered under the PMP. Communities within the proposed plan area are: Coal Harbour, Port Alice, Holberg, Port McNeill and Winter Harbour. The areas to be treated are primarily harvested cutblocks and road right-of-ways.

The proposed duration of the Pest Management Plan is 5 years from August 1st, 2017-August 1st, 2021.
