

## WFP - Columbia Vista Doug-fir 'XX Sort' specifications

**General Quality** 

Logs must be cut from Green Sound Timber.

Diameter

Min 13"top dia

**Ring Count** 

6 rings or more in the outer two thirds of the radius.

(Defined as "close grain" 6-30 rings per inch, or 5 rings with 1/3 summerwood.)

## **Knot distribution & quality:**

• Knots less then <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" not considered.

- Knots <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" to 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" well scattered with no more than 1 per foot of log. An occasional larger knot allowed in the upper half of long logs.
- The first 10' of the butt segment must be free of knots (Knots less then 3/4" will not be considered as long as the remainder of the log meets specs)
- No more than 10% defect.

## WFP - Columbia Vista Doug-fir 'Export' specifications

Logs must be cut from Green Sound Timber.

Diameter

- Min 12" top dia,

Ring Count

- N/A

**Knot distribution:** 

Unlimited knots up to 1 ½".

- Knots from 1 ½" to 2", limited to an average of 1 per foot of log length.
- Knots over 2", confined to no more of 25% of the total surface.
- No more than 15% defect.

## **'XX & Export' Sort Defect Guidelines:**

- No more than 3" twist per linear foot of log.
- Only minor pitch ring: no more than 1 ring (less than 8" dia)
- Only minor pitch/frost crack: no more than 3 arms (less than 6" long)
- Maximum 1 snow break per log. No double heart. No hooked or pistol butts.
- Heart/butt rot less than 5.0" in diameter.
- Sweep: tape must not leave the log when stretched center to center, and log must recover straight 10'+ segments.
- No more than one (1) spike knot not over 1 ½".
- Max Butt 38" (wide way inside bark). Log butts 34"-38" in dia may be purchased at a discounted price.
