FINISHING AND MAINTENANCE

- Western Red Cedar can be allowed to weather naturally to a silvery grey look, or a wide range of stains and coatings can be applied to ensure maximum performance.
- For best results coat all six sides before installation.
- New cedar boards that are going to be finished should be protected from the weather before finish has been applied.
- Allow product to acclimatize to the environment where it will be installed to avoid unwanted shrinkage or expansion.

- Fasteners with corrosion resistance should be used. Hot-dipped galvanized or stainless steel.
- **Important Note:** Never power-wash a deck because it damages the wood fibers.
