

Environmental Policy

Western Forest Products and its wholly-owned subsidiaries (“Western”) are committed to protecting the environment, preventing pollution, ensuring the sustainability of the natural resources in our care and continually improving our environmental performance. Western is committed to encouraging and working with our partners, including related entities, to uphold the principles in this Policy and to adopt similar policies in their businesses.

At Western, we engage employees, contractors, First Nations and Indigenous peoples, government agencies, customers, suppliers and communities to identify and address issues of environmental concern in all aspects of our operations.

Our goal is to conduct our business in compliance with all applicable environmental legislation, ensure sustainable management of our natural resources and meet our customers' needs. This goal is supported through the development, implementation and adherence to environmental management systems which:

- Identify and evaluate potential environmental impacts, as well as apply all applicable statutory requirements relating to our operations;
- Allocate and provide sufficient resources and training to ensure effective implementation and maintenance of our environmental management systems;
- Establish environmental objectives and targets that reflect our commitment to continual improvement;
- Deliver continual improvements in our environmental practices and energy conservation;
- Monitor, audit and report our environmental performance;
- Advance environmental awareness and engagement among our internal and external stakeholders and the First Nations on whose traditional territories we operate; and
- Align third-party certification efforts with market and customer needs.

All of Western employees and service providers accept the responsibility to:

- Participate in training and receive proper qualifications prior to engaging in work;
- Report environmental impacts or occurrences;
- Adhere to environmental operational practices and requirements; and
- Respect and support this Environmental Policy.
